Charles Bertan Wheeler, Jr. was born on August 10, 1926, in Kansas City, Missouri. He earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Louisville, in Louisville, Kentucky, in 1946. After graduation, Wheeler attended the University of Kansas Medical School where he earned a medical degree in 1950.

Wheeler served as a flight surgeon in the United States Air Force during the Korean War. Upon returning to Kansas City, Missouri, after his military service, he worked as a pathologist. During this time, Wheeler began attending evening classes at the University of Kansas City Law School where he earned a Juris Doctor degree in 1959. In 1964, he was elected as the Jackson County Coroner. Wheeler served two terms as the Western Judge of the Jackson County Court and was elected Mayor of Kansas City, Missouri, in 1971. After a defeat for reelection as mayor in 1979, Wheeler returned to his position as director of the Wheeler Medical Laboratories in Kansas City, Missouri. He was elected as a Missouri Senator in 2002 and served one term.
