The collection contains five scrapbooks kept by George Herbert Edwards, mayor of Kansas City, Missouri. Additional materials include correspondence, telegrams, a photograph, a wedding announcement for Edwards' daughter, a pamphlet, and a memorial booklet for Edwards' mother.

George Herbert Edwards was born on May 25, 1860, in St. Louis, Missouri, to Richard and Betsey Josslyn Sampson Edwards. He married Isabella Dix on November 20, 1889. Edwards was a member of the Upper House of Common Council from 1906 to 1914. He served as mayor of Kansas City, Missouri, from 1916 to 1918. Edwards was an active member of the Republican Party in Kansas City, Missouri, and was a member of the Masonic Order.
