The Kansas City Aero Club, an affiliate of the Aero Club of America, was organized by Charles J. Glidden in 1909 in Kansas City, Missouri. The Club organized and participated in a number of aeronautics and ballooning contests across the United States. George M. Myers served as the Club's first president.
