The Kansas City Study of Adult Life Records consist of interviews, surveys, and research notes pertaining to a series of studies conducted by the Committee on Human Development at the University of Chicago. Additional materials include case files, organizational files, reports, forms, and study samples.

The Committee on Human Development was founded in 1940 at the University of Chicago by Dr. Richard Scammons, dean of the Division of the Biological Sciences, and professors Frank N. Freeman of the Department of Education, Lydia J. Roberts of the Department of Home Economics, Helen L. Koch of the Department of Child Development, Dr. Frederic W. Schlutz of the Department of Pediatrics, and Donald Slesinger, Associate Dean of the Division of the Social Sciences. The primary objectives of the committee were to conduct research on human behavior through the life cycle and to contribute to the understanding of the developmental processes within the human psychological development and social sciences. The committee was also tasked with training students for careers in research and teaching.
