Abstract: This is an artificial collection of photographs from a variety of sources collected by the Native Sons and Daughters of Greater Kansas City. It includes photos of famous Kansas City buildings, street views, arts and culture, commerce and industry, damage from natural disasters, and notable Kansas Citians. The collection primarily contains materials from the 1870s to the 1920s, although there are both earlier and later photographs included in the collection.

Collection Size: 3 cubic feet (147 folders, 771 photographs, 66 postcards, 159 stereograph cards, 47 glass plate negatives)

Language: Collection materials are in English.

Historical Note:

The Native Sons of Greater Kansas City formed in the fall of 1932. The organization is dedicated to the historic preservation of the unique and rich heritage of the greater Kansas City metropolitan area, both in Missouri and Kansas, through advocacy, education and restoration. The organization also seeks to preserve items and documents of historical interest pertaining to the development, people, and activities of the Kansas City area. The organization changed its name to the Native Sons and Daughters of Greater Kansas City to accurately reflect its membership base.

Scope and Content Note:

Art and culture

This series contains photographs related to arts and culture in Kansas City. There are two subseries; Music, which contains a photograph of a sign for “Epperson’s Megaphone Minstrels,” and Statues, which contains photographs of the statue titled, “The Scout.” Items are arranged by medium.

Built Environment

This series consists of photographs pertaining to the built environment in Kansas City from the late 1800s to the mid 1900s. It is broken into 32 subseries. These subseries include Bridges, Postcards, Stereograph Cards Album #1-5, Street views- City Market, Industrial District, Parks and Boulevards; Street Views Photo Album #1-2, Street Views- Residential, Theodore S. Case Scrapbook, Topographical views, Buildings- Aviation, Clubs and Clubhouses, Educational, Oak Hall; Nelson Atkins, Schools, Government, Photograph Album, Memorials, Recreational, Religious, Residential, Apartments and Hotels, Residential, Dilapidated; Residential, Individual

Residences; Residential, Unidentified Residences; Liberty Memorial, and Liberty Memorial Photo Album. Items are organized by type and then subject.

Commerce and Industry

This series contains photographs related to Commerce and Industry in Kansas City from 1872-1944. There are 4 subseries; Agriculture, Business District, Commercial, and Industrial. Materials are organized by subject.

Organizations

This series consists of photographs of the Commercial Club and its members. There are portraits and photographs of club events. Photographs span from approximately 1907-1914, although some photos are undated.

Natural Disasters

This series contains photographs of floods that struck Kansas City from 1903-1941 and their ensuing damage. There are street views as well as photographs of the riverbanks and damage to the city. There are 3 subseries, Floods- 1903, Floods- 1908, and Floods- 1941. This series is organized chronologically.

People

This series consists of portraits and other photographs of people related to Kansas City. There are 4 subseries, People- Identified, Groups and Events, Pratt and Fisk families, and People- Unidentified. The photographs are largely undated, but span from approximately 1875-1952. This series is organized by subject. People- Identified is organized alphabetically.

Glass Plate Negatives

This series contains glass plate negatives from many of the above series. There are street views, homes, bridges, flood damage, businesses, and a map of Kansas City. This series is organized alphabetically.
