The collection consists of programs, printed materials, and items related to public relations for historical and cultural activities in the Kansas City metropolitan area collected by Barbara Ann Magerl, a writer and local historian.

Barbara Ann Campbell was born on February 7, 1932, to John W. and Caroline Dougherty Campbell. Barbara married Howard Magerl in the 1950s. She was a writer and local historian who worked with the Oregon-California Trails Association, Historic Kansas City, Shawnee Indian Mission, Kansas State Historical Society, Johnson County Museum, and Missouri Town 1855. Magerl wrote numerous articles on the regional history of the Kansas City area for the Kansas City Public Library and led various tours of Kansas City. Magerl died on April 15, 2016, and is buried at Resurrection Cemetery in Lenexa, Kansas.
