#### **Historical Note:**

In October 1863, Reverend Clark Moore, Reverend John Loving, and Reverend Anderson came to Kansas City, Missouri, and held an organizational meeting at Straggler's Camp, located between Fourth and Delaware and Wyandotte Streets. After the meeting, Reverend John Loving organized the congregation of Black Methodists into the church that is now known as Allen Chapel A.M.E. Church. In 1866, Reverend Loving moved the church to a frame building at Tenth and Charlotte. Reverend Loving served as the church's pastor until Reverend William B. Ousley assumed the position. In 1896, Reverend Jesse Peck oversaw the construction of Allen Chapel. In 1960, Allen Chapel was relocated to its present address at 4125 Benton Boulevard, Kansas City, Missouri.

## **Scope and Content Note:**

This collection contains church bulletins and programs, correspondence, board and financial reports, newsletters, conference information, newspaper clippings, and board minutes related to Allen Chapel A.M.E. Church and the Connectional Lay Organization of the A.M.E. Church. Also included are church bulletins and programs from churches in Missouri and Kansas. Folder 49 consists of miscellaneous materials related to Allen Chapel A.M.E. Church. Folder 50 contains loose pages from church bulletins that are undated and unidentified.
