Little historical information can be found on Nell G. Thornburg. It is known that she was raised in Kansas City, Missouri. During World War I, she served as an army nurse. After the war she met and married Dr. Maurice Thornburg and for a time they lived in Chicago, Illinois.

The collection contains a typed travel diary by Nell Thornburg documenting her first guided world tour in 1960 and her second guided world tour in 1962. Thornburg's first guided world tour included the countries of Japan, Taiwan, Thailand, Indonesia, Singapore, India, Egypt, Syria, Istanbul, and Greece. Her second guided world tour included the countries of Poland, Russia, Finland, Sweden, Norway, Denmark, and Scotland.
