Historical Note:

B'nai B'rith Women (renamed Jewish Women International in 1995) began in 1897 as a women's organization within B'nai B'rith International. It is an international group, with members in Canada, Europe, Israel, and the United States, engaged in advocacy for women and the Jewish community. In 1990, B'nai B'rith Women became independent of its parent organization, B'nai B'rith International, and in 1995, it was renamed Jewish Women International.

Arrangement:

The collection is arranged in original order by the creator. Materials within the collection were originally part of a bound scrapbook. Scrapbook pages were removed from their original binding because of preservation concerns.
