Abstract: The Florence Goldfinger Pack Collection contains photographs and clippings concerning Florence Pack, dating from 1933 to 1988. The collection contains a mixture of dated and undated materials, with mediums ranging from newspaper clippings to photographs. Many of the items are school related.

Historical Note:

Florence "Flossie" Goldfinger Pack was born in the early 1900s. Pack attended the Keneseth Israel-Beth Sholom Synagogue Schools throughout her life and was involved in organizing for the Menorah Medical Center in Kansas City. Some of the photographs in the collection concern Pack's education, with two images from later in her life with the Medical Center.

Arrangement:

The collection has been arranged by type.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection contains five total photographs, with two of the photos being undated. The first photo is from 1933, detailing Florence Goldfinger Pack in a class photo from a newspaper clipping during her youth at a religious institution. The next photo is undated but depicts Pack in her teenage years. In the oversized folder, there is a larger, professional photograph of Pack's confirmation class from 1943. The next photo is another newspaper clipping from 1988, which depicts Pack and other organizing members of a Marquise Ball dedicated to the Menorah Medical Center. The final photo is undated, but most likely was taken around the time of the photograph from 1988.
