Abstract: The Kansas City Photographs contain various photos taken throughout the city between 1920 and 1957 at many different locations. A large portion of the photos are dedicated to close shots of many historic buildings and homes of the city. The rest of the photos are aerial views of the city, with shots of the many statues within the city. There is also a small portion of the collection that is dedicated to the animals of the Kansas City Zoo.

Historical Note:

The Kansas City Photographs are a series of various photographs that were taken between the years of 1920 and 1957, with many of them being in the 1930s and 1940s. These photographs predominately feature historic buildings and areas of the city, with closeup shots and aerial views of the buildings. A portion of the photographs feature different monuments located in the city and animals that can be seen in the Kansas City Zoo. Many of the animal photographs were taken in the 1940s. Many of the buildings and monuments seen in the photographs still exist during the 21st century.

Arrangement:

The collection has been arranged by photograph subject.

Scope and Content Note:

This photograph collection contains various photographs, with and without dates and addresses on the back of each photograph. The photographs without dates were likely taken around the same time period as the other photographs.

The first five folders consist of building photographs. The first two folders contain closeup shots of residences in the Kansas City area, followed by three folders of commercial buildings. These buildings are primarily focused in the downtown area and the surrounding area around Kansas City. The building photographs include shots of churches, houses, office buildings, and larger factories.

The two city views folders consist of wide, all-encompassing photographs of the overall city. These photographs lack a particular subject, but rather focuses on the full scene. There are many aerial photographs, ground-level photographs, and other scenic views in Kansas City.

The statues folder contains photographs of the many statues that can be found within the city. Many of these photographs are of war memorial statues and commemoration statues, rather than artistic ones.

The final folder contains photographs of animals at the Kansas City Zoo in the 1940s. These photographs consist of a large range of animals such as lions, tigers, ostriches, and zebras.
