**Biographical Note:**

Albert Lee Evans was born in Commerce, Missouri, on November 28, 1871. He was the son of John Wesley Evans and Eliza Peterman Evans. After his family moved to Farmington, Evans worked as a teacher and on a Mississippi River steamboat to finance his education. He studied medicine at Barnes Medical College in Saint Louis, and graduated in 1900. He later completed postgraduate courses at Washington University in Saint Louis and New York. He set up practice in Bonne Terre, Missouri, in 1900 and built up a large general and pediatric practice. He died on December 29, 1958, and is buried in the Bonne Terre Cemetery.
