Historical Note:

Mine La Motte, a town in Madison County, Missouri, prospered in the late nineteenth and early twentieth century. Settled in 1717 by the French and their slaves, the town was immediately the site of lead mining. The first mine in Missouri, operations continued through the twentieth century with numerous companies operating in the area during its history.

Arrangement:

The collection has been arranged in its original order in one folder.

Scope and Content Note:

The collection contains a photocopy of Ferris H. Van Sickle's term paper, "History of Mine La Motte." Van Sickle wrote the history as a term project for a class in history at Southeast Missouri State University at Cape Girardeau. In a cover letter to Dr. Barron, Van Sickle mentions a Dr. Collins, presumably a professor for whom the paper was written.
