**Biographical Note:**

Harry C. Hood Sr. was born December 28, 1905 in southwest Missouri to John and Bell Hood. He married Blanche Harrington in 1926, and together they had one child, Harry Jr. Hood Sr. worked in a mill house in the mining industry as a young man. He died on April 28, 1989 in Jasper County, Missouri.

### Scope and Content Note:

#### Manuscripts

This series contains Hood's unpublished manuscripts on mining in southwest Missouri. The manuscripts include, two on the Schoenherr-Walton Mining Company, remembrances of Edgar Z. Wallower about the Southwest Missouri Railroad, and mines in Jasper County, Missouri. Folder 2 contains a compiled list of mines in Jasper County; the manuscript also contains a section with a compilation of mining accident fatalities from 1906. This series is arranged in its original order.

#### Newspaper Articles

This series consists of newspaper articles written by Hood for the *Webb City Sentinel*. The articles in stories on specific mines, the value of ore, mining camps, mining towns, early businesses, and various other topics related to mining operations and the communities surrounding them. Also included are images of southwest Missouri mines. The series is arranged chronologically.
