Abstract: The Archibald McIntyre Robertson Papers contain an original and typescript journal that records the journey of Archibald Robertson through Europe, the Mediterranean, Egypt, the Sinai, and Palestine in 1856-1857.

Biographical Note:

Archibald McIntyre Robertson was born in 1833 to Archibald and Elizabeth Robertson. The family lived in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and New York. Archibald M. served in the Union army as an aid in General Barry's command under General McClellan. He traveled abroad with companions in the late 1850s. He died in November 1866, at the age of 23. His death record lists his occupation as gentleman.

Arrangement:

The collection has been arranged in its original order in two folders.

Scope and Content Note:

The collection contains the journal of Archibald McIntyre Robertson written during his trip through Europe, the Mediterranean, Egypt, the Sinai, and Palestine from September 1856 through July 1857. The first pages are fragments of a letter written to his parents describing his voyage across the Atlantic and his arrival in Liverpool, England. The first journal entry is dated September 7, 1856 from London. Robertson and his companions, Augustus Graham Coleman, Samuel Richards Colwell, John Hamilton Slack, and 'Doctor' travelled Europe for the next two months. They visited Belgium, Holland, Germany, Austria, and Italy. The party then crossed the Mediterranean to Egypt landing at Alexandria after a stop at Malta. They then travelled to Cairo and took a trip down the Nile River to Thebes. The group spent two weeks visiting locations from the Bible and they took a steamship to France. The last journal entry was on July 5, 1857 in Paris, France.

Robertson describes his travels including European capitals, Mediterranean seaports, sandstorms, Bedouins, local governments, historic sites, and architecture. He considered Berlin the finest capitol and was least impressed with Rome and Italy. His opinion was undoubtedly affected by his low opinion of Roman Catholicism. He made several remarks while visiting Catholic sites in Jerusalem that were disparaging. Accompanying the journal is a typescript as the original journal is difficult to read in numerous places.
