Abstract: The Logan Club Records contain photocopies of the financial records of a political club in Marble Hill, Bollinger County, Missouri. The group supported the Benjamin Harrison and Levi P. Morton national Republican ticket in the presidential election of 1888.

Historical Note:

The Logan Club was a political group organized in Marble Hill, Bollinger County, Missouri. They supported the national Republican presidential ticket of Benjamin Harrison and Levi P. Morton. The club was probably named in honor of John Alexander Logan, a Union Civil War general and Radical Republican from Illinois who had been James G. Blaine's running mate in 1884.
