Historical Note:

The Moark Land and Timber Company was a timber exploitation and lumber business located in southeast Missouri, headquartered in Caruthersville, Pemiscot County, Missouri. Franklin Johnson Cunningham served as its manager at the turn of the 20th century. Cunningham, along with his three brothers operated sawmills and lumber businesses across the Bootheel region of Missouri.
