Biographical Note:

Lucy M. Wright was born in 1837, in New York to Elisha and Sophronia Manley Wright. She married Asa W. Knapp in Wayne County, New York, and together they had one child, Frank W. Asa's mother was a Stoddard by birth. He died in 1860, and is buried the Marion cemetery in Wayne County, New York. Lucy married Benjamin L. Knapp in 1868. They lived in Phelps County, Missouri, and together they had four children, Charles M., Theron Lorenzo, Harlon, and Arthur B. Benjamin. Benjamin died in 1911, followed by Lucy in 1931.

Scope and Content Note:

The collection contains a letter from Lucy Knapp in Rolla, Missouri to Asa Stoddard of Kalamazoo, Michigan in 1903. Asa was a relative of her first husband, Asa Russell's, mother. The letter contains a general description of Rolla and information about members of the Knapp family. A cover letter by the donor includes comments about Rolla in 1941.
