Historical Note:

R.E. McArron produced a promotional pamphlet to inform the public of the real conditions of the Missouri Ozarks. From Long Lane, Missouri, McArron promoted his local area describing it as the garden spot of the world, and that the soils were particularly well suited for growing grain and fruit-culture. R.E. McArron was born in August 1882, to William and Almira McArron. A lifelong resident of Dallas County, Missouri he worked various jobs such as a mail carrier, postmaster, local merchant, and county treasurer.
