### **Historical Note:**

The St. Patrick Church in Rolla, Missouri, was established in 1862, to serve Irish railroad workers and their families who had come to Phelps County in the course of construction of the South West Branch of the Pacific Railroad. Father Francis Patrick Gallagher was the first pastor. Gallagher and his successors were also active in the mission field and established Catholic churches at St. James, Rosati, and Beulah in Phelps County, and at Cuba, Dixon, Pomona, and Salem in Missouri.
