Historical Note:

Hochstatter School was located in a rural school district 2½ miles south of Potosi, Missouri in Washington County. The school began on April 5, 1879 with a meeting at the "old store house at Crammer's sawmill." C. V. F. Hochstatter donated an acre of ground for a building site and was elected district clerk. A petition in 1891 resulted in building a new school on a site closer to the center of the district. The new site was on an acre tract donated by Charles O. Seyfarth, a school director and district clerk succeeding C. V. F. Hochstatter. Hochstatter School was also known as Seyfarth School.

Arrangement:

The collection has been arranged in its original order.

Scope and Content Note:

The collection contains records of the Hochstatter School located in Washington County, Missouri. The records include a record book with school meeting minutes, directors' proceedings, financial records, enumeration of youth, register of orders, register of teachers, district clerk's report, and oaths of school directors. The collection also contains a teacher's register which includes attendance records, school curriculum, a visitors' register, and summary of attendance and achievement.
