Historical Note:

The Vital Ste. Gemme Beauvais, Jean Baptiste Valle, and Louis Bolduc houses were built in 1785. The Charles Gregoire house was built in 1780. The Francois Janis house was built in 1790. The Francis Rozier house was built in 1848. The Catholic Church was built in 1834.

Historic Houses

This series contains photographs of the Vital Ste. Gemme Beauvais, Louis Bolduc, Charles Gregoire, Francois Janis, Francis Rozier and Jean Baptiste Valle house in Sainte Genevieve, Missouri. Also include is a print of a sketch drawing of the Catholic Church built in 1834. This series is arranged in its original order.

Ste. Genevieve Steamboat

This series contains 35mm negative copies of images of the steamboat *Ste. Genevieve* both the wooden-hulled railroad ferryboat and the steel-hulled vessel which bore the same name. Images of the *Ste. Genevieve* include scenes from the winter of 1912 when the river froze. Also included is an image of the children of John Garretson. This series is arranged in its original order.
