Historical Note:

The Theta Rho Girls' Clubs are auxiliaries to the Independent Order of Odd Fellows and are closely allied with the Daughters of Rebekah. The stated purpose of the clubs was the self-improvement of its members, but they seem to have been largely social organizations. The Beta Phi Theta Rho Girls' Club in Joplin counted about ten active members in their early teens during the period between 1946 and 1950.

Arrangement:

The collection has been arranged in its original order.

Scope and Content Note:

This minute book of the Beta Phi Theta Rho Girls' Club at Joplin in Jasper County, Missouri, begins January 28, 1946, and continues through December 27, 1950. Regular business included the initiation of members and installation of officers, and planning for events in conjunction with other Theta Rho, Rebekah, and Odd Fellows lodges.
