Historical Note:

Twelve women met at the home of Noble Grand Goldie Kirk in Webb City on October 25, 1933, to organize the Rebekah Homemakers' Club. The club was composed of members of the Rebekah Lodge at Webb City, who met to socialize and to raise money for the Odd Fellows Home in Liberty, Missouri. The purpose of the club was "to create a social interest among its members and to do our bit toward contributing to the IOOF home." Among the club's fundraising activities were a quilt raffle and rummage sales.

Scope and Content Note:

This series minutes of meetings and membership records of the Rebekah Homemaker's Club at Webb City, Missouri. Minutes begin with the organizational meeting of October 25, 1933, and continue through April 14, 1939.
