#### **Historical Note:**

The Clinton & Great Western Nurseries operated in Clinton, Henry County, Missouri and through a branch in Kansas City during the 1900s and 1910s. John Barnhart and his son Edward

A. were the proprietors. Edward A. managed the Clinton location, and John handled the Kansas City branch. John and Susan Barnhart moved with their family to Missouri in 1865 from Ohio.

Edward served as mayor of Clinton, Missouri at times, but also moved between Clinton and Kansas City, Missouri. At the end of his life Edward was living in Kansas City and working as the president of the Eads Water Company. Edward died in November 1927 and is buried in Forest Hill Cemetery in Kansas City.
