This is the "Premium List and Program" for the second annual Taney County Fair, held at Forsyth, Missouri, on 22-24 September 1938.

The Taney County Fair, sometimes referred to in the booklet as the Taney County Free Fair, offered several of the usual agricultural exhibitions and competitions common to the genre. The major categories were a "Pig and Calf Show" for youths, "Poultry," "Produce," and a "Women's Division" featuring domestic arts such as sewing, canning, cooking, and "fancy work."

The President of the Fair's board was C. H. Burdett, assisted by Secretary C. E. Middleton and Mrs. I. O. Parrish, Treasurer. Division chairs were E. B. Adams, Frank A. Dawes, Ernest Rea, and Mrs. George Renshaw.

The White River Leader and the Taney County Republican published the 20-page program.
