Historical Note:

Perry County, Missouri experienced a substantial immigration of Germans in the nineteenth century, including many Evangelicals (Lutherans). The Immanuel Lutheran School was consecrated on September 6, 1908. The school originally taught lessons in both German and

English. The congregation and school exist today as Immanuel Lutheran Church and Immanuel Lutheran School in Perryville. The congregation is an affiliate of the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod.

Arrangement:

The collection has been arranged in its original order in one folder.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection contains a program from the consecration of the Lutheran school at Perryville, Missouri, on September 6, 1908. Most of the document is in German with an English translation provided by Dr. Petra DeWitt. The program includes the orders of service at the church and school, and a list of school leaders. Pastor Fr. Klug of Farmington, Missouri and Reverend H.A. Klein of Wittenberg, Missouri delivered celebratory sermons.
