This is a booklet describing and promoting Arcadia College and Ursuline Academy, a school for girls located at Arcadia in Iron County, Missouri, and run by the Ursuline Sisters, a Roman Catholic order. Included are photographic illustrations and descriptions of the courses of study.

Arcadia College and Ursuline Academy was established in 1877 by the Ursuline Sisters, an order of the Roman Catholic Church. It provided primary, preparatory, and high-school education, along with commercial and musical instruction, to female students, many of whom boarded at the school. This 48-page undated booklet describes the courses of study, rules, and fees at the school. The school closed its doors for the final time in 1971.
