This is a letter dated 27 March 1933 from Deleta Condray of Bangert in Dent County, Missouri, to the Directors of the Adams School District in Phelps County, Missouri. In the letter Condray applies for a teaching job at the school.

In the letter Condray noted that she would “graduate from the St. James High School in May, having then completed a special course for teachers.” As references she named Leta Ray Locke, the teacher training instructor at St. James, and Helene Bircher, the teacher training instructor at Salem, Missouri.
