These are the time book and miscellaneous business papers of the Sligo Furnace Company in Dent County, Missouri. The time book includes the names, occupations, and wages of workers from April 1898 through March 1900. The miscellaneous papers include an inventory of the property in 1904, and papers concerning operation of the Sligo Mercantile Company stores at Sligo and East End, and the operation and abandonment of the Sligo and Eastern Railroad Company.

The Sligo Furnace Company was formed to exploit iron deposits in Crawford, Dent and Phelps counties, first noted by surveyor E. B. Sankey along the line of the St. Louis, Salem and Little Rock Railway. Sankey invited A. L. Crawford of New Castle, Pennsylvania, H. A. Crawford of St. Louis, Missouri; A. J. Crawford of Terre Haute, Indiana; J. P. Crawford of Missouri; and David Carson, former superintendent of the Maramec Iron Works in Phelps County, Missouri, to inspect the area's prospects. As a result, the Crawfords and Carson determined to build a furnace along Crooked Creek in Dent County, a site within reach of the St. Louis, Salem & Little Rock Railway and close to plentiful deposits of iron ore, limestone for flux, and timber for charcoal-making. Consequently, the Crawfords and Carson incorporated the Sligo Furnace Company (a Missouri corporation named after the Sligo forges near Pittsburg, Pennsylvania), capitalized at \$30,000. H. A. Crawford of St. Louis was the major shareholder, with 150 shares; his brothers and David Carson held 120 shares. After the purchase of land in January 1880 for a furnace site, the company was recapitalized at \$100,000. David Carson supervised construction and operation of the plant until his death.

The company's physical plant took shape in 1880. The original furnace consisted of an iron-cased furnace stack resting on cast-iron columns and mantle. Loaded from above with 80 bushels of charcoal, 3,300 bushels of iron ore, and 330 pounds of limestone, forced air blast raised the temperature in the furnace to the melting point. Molten metal trickled into a crucible tapped twice daily to produce "pigs' of raw cast iron in sand (later iron) molds. The furnace, rebuilt in 1891, produced 100 tons of iron daily and had an annual capacity of 25,000 tons. The process, once started, was more or less continuous. The spectacular "tappings" of the furnace were well-attended by community residents as well as visitors to Sligo.

Sligo's iron ore came from mines in Dent, Crawford and Phelps counties, including those at Simmons Hill, Cherry Valley, Pomeroy, Clinton, Hawkins Bank, Plank, Stephens, Orchard, and others. Wagons hauled ore from the mines to points along the St. Louis, Salem and Little Rock Railway (later the St. Louis-San Francisco Railway's Salem Branch) between Salem and Steelville, and along a spur built from the Salem Branch to the furnace at Sligo. Later the company incorporated the Sligo and Eastern Railroad to haul ore and timber from as far east as Iron County.

A corollary operation at Sligo was the charcoal-making process. Workers produced fuel for the furnace on site in large conical-shaped kilns with a capacity of forty-five to fifty-five cords of wood each. Eventually there were seventy-two kilns at Sligo with an annual capacity of 2,160,000 bushels of charcoal. From the charcoal-making process, wood alcohol and other distillates were recovered, making Sligo what now would be termed an integrated plant.

The village of Sligo, built specially by the company to house its workers, grew up immediately west of the furnace complex. About a thousand residents lived in one hundred frame houses rented from the company. The village also featured a school and church funded and built by the company, and a small business area consisting of a hotel, general store, feed store, barbershop, and other shops. The superintendent's house, dubbed the "mansion," overlooked the entire complex.

The Sligo Furnace lasted longer than any of the other iron furnaces in Missouri, most of which went out of business after a protective tariff on iron was discontinued in 1893. Sligo continued to smelt iron after the change in tariff, stockpiling 900,000 tons before sales picked up after 1897. Despite increased competition from the iron centers of the Great Lakes, Sligo survived by selling higher grade iron to be blended with inferior metal for railroad car wheels and axles at foundries in St. Louis and elsewhere. Edward F. Goltra (1862-1920) of St. Louis bought the company in 1898. Later the American Car and Foundry Company of St. Louis acquired Sligo Furnace Company, after which Goltra became president of American Car and Foundry.

After World War One, American Car and Foundry determined to shut down the increasingly unprofitable operation in Dent County. When the furnace "blew out" in 1923, it ended the livelihoods of hundreds of workers, some of whom had labored at Sligo their entire adult lives. Gradually the townspeople moved away; most of the buildings are no longer extant. Today only a few structures remain, notably the church (now Sligo United Methodist Church) and school, remain to mark the site of the once-thriving industrial community, but former residents and their descendants still hold reunions at Sligo.

The records of the Sligo Furnace Company derive from William Dey Marshall (1879-1928), Sligo's last superintendent. Marshall, an alumnus of Blees Military Academy in Macon, Missouri, was a chemist and executive of the American Car and Foundry Company. He arrived in 1923 to supervise closure of the furnace and to look after the company's other interests. Those included the Sligo and Eastern railroad (its operations continued until 1930) and the company's mercantile business through the general stores at Sligo and East End. Marshall died on 21 December 1928; his widow, Mary, continued to live on the property. In 1930, she acquired the superintendent's residence, store building and several hundred acres at Sligo from American Car and Foundry. Most of the property has remained in family hands since. Robert W. Marshall, Jr., William Dey Marshall's grandson, recovered the Sligo records in this collection from outbuildings on the property and loaned them for microfilming.

The earliest item in the collection is a time book for company employees at Sligo. The time book begins April 1898 and continues through March 1900. Some of the pages in the volume have suffered corner and edge damage from rodents during years of storage, but most of the information survived. The time book contains the names of nearly eight hundred employees, the kind of labor performed, daily wage and number of days worked per month, deductions for rent, merchandise, and livestock feed from the company store, and monthly totals. Recapitulations for each month are tipped in. Separate figures for work at the "Steelville Bank" and sinking a shaft on "Seay land" in 1900 are at the end of the volume. An alphabetical list of all the employees and the years they worked has been prepared and filmed in front of the volume.

The miscellaneous papers, 1904-1934, have been arranged in two parts. Folders 1-5 concern the operations at the furnace, the discontinuance of the Sligo and Eastern Railroad in 1933, and matters concerning the community at Sligo. The earliest item (Folder 1) is a 199-page "General Summary" (inventory) of the property and assets of the Sligo Furnace Company on 1 January 1904. Prepared by an American Car and Foundry Company auditor, the inventory has categories for furnace, by-product, and general store operations. The summary also lists timber rights and other company assets exclusive of land holdings. The auditor noted the monetary value of each item, from iron "pigs" at the furnace to hair crimpers at the stores, and valued the company's property at \$170,271. Folders 2-3 show aspects of John W. Marshall's work with American Car and Foundry, including his work with the Quinn Furnace Company at Gadsden, Alabama, his expense reports for 1912-1914, and a 1924 letter concerning the mercantile trade at stores along the Sligo and Eastern Railroad. Folder 4 contains papers regarding the Sligo and Eastern Railroad and its discontinuance; folder 5 contains papers concerning the school, church services, and the post office at Sligo.

Folders 6-24 contain correspondence and business papers of the company's mercantile operations, supervised by William D. Marshall after the furnace blew out. They concern the general stores at Sligo (doing business as the Sligo Mercantile Company) and East End (the Station Store). The papers consist primarily of Marshall's correspondence with wholesale houses and suppliers, and include requests for prices and samples, orders for goods, invoices, adjustments of account, and advertising. Most of the general store business involved groceries, hardware, and dry goods. Among the firms represented in the correspondence are Armour and Company, Swift & Company, St. Louis-San Francisco Railway, Neosho Nurseries Company, Schreiner Hay Company (Lamar, Mo.), and the St. Louis firms Butler Brothers, Carleton Dry Goods Company, Graham Paper Company, Haas- Lieber Grocery Company, Heydt Bakery, J. Johnson & Company, Landau Grocery Company, Scudder-Gale Grocer Company, and Scullin Steel Company.
