ORGANIZATIONAL SKETCH

General Electric (GE) was founded in 1892 by Charles Coffin and Thomas Edison. The company was created from a merger of the founders' companies, Edison General Electric Company and Thomson-Houston Electric Company. The publication bureau of GE was located in Schenectady, New York, in the early 20th century. Today GE is headquartered in Boston, Massachusetts, and is one of the most profitable companies in the United States.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection consists of two volumes of General Electric bulletins published in 1915 and 1917. The bulletins are guides to the various products manufactured by the company.
