Historical Note:

The Associated Electric Cooperative Inc. (AECI) was created in 1961 when Missouri's rural electric cooperatives pooled their resources. AECI became the top tier of a three-tier system the served the electrical needs of rural Missouri and parts of Iowa. The need for such a large organization came from the fact that smaller power supply companies found serving sparsely populated rural areas too costly. The companies found running electric lines cost-prohibitive and often placed the cost of running the line on the consumers who were unable to pay the extra charge. By 1995, AECI was serving a total of 1.2 million consumers.
