Abstract: The James Memorial Public Library Photograph Collection contains negative copies of photographs brought to the library in St. James by residence who lived in town and the surrounding area. The original images date from the 1870s to the 1990s and include family portraits, city scenes, local businesses, area schools, events, parades, weddings, and church activities among many others. The majority of the photographs are from Phelps County with representation from Crawford and Dent counties.

Historical Note:

Upon her death in 1938, Lucy Wortham James left the city of St. James \$700 a year to go towards supporting a public library. The fund was under the direction of the James Foundation for the next 60 years and grew to support the library. The city contracted a new building in 1953, and named it the Lucy Wortham James Memorial Library, more commonly known as the James Memorial Public Library today. The James Foundation gifted the library and its contents to the city of St. James in May 2013.

Scope and Content Note:**Negatives**

This series contains over 4,000 negative copies of photographs brought to the James Memorial Library by St. James residents. These negatives include images of St. James, Rosati, Salem and Phelps County, of families, parades, businesses, the St. Louis-San Francisco Railroad, the Federal Soldiers Home (now the Missouri Veterans Home), schools, and weddings among many others. The negatives starting with K include several images of a divided street, possibly Springfield Street in St. James, Missouri. The negatives starting with P are portrait style images of individuals, couples, and groups. The images were numbered as they were copied and this series was kept in that original order.

Glass Plate Negatives

This series contains glass plate negatives ranging from 2x3 inches in size to 7x9. Glass plate negatives No. 1-19 are images of Maramec Spring, Meramec River, and the old iron works. They appear to have been taken at the same time. The other negatives include images of the James family home, Dunmoor, Maramec Spring, ruins of the Maramec Iron Works, and local schools. This series is arranged by size of negative.
