**Scope and Content Note:**

**Municipalities**

Primarily consisting of single folder accessions, this series contains histories, comprehensive plans, directories, reports, maps, and newspaper clippings, documenting St. Louis County municipalities, including Affton, Pine Lawn, Kinloch, and the Village of Champ. In addition, this series includes materials on Kinloch, the oldest African American municipality in Missouri, such as *Kinloch: Yesterday, Today, and Tomorrow*, a history of the community, and directories for businesses and municipal services in Kinloch. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1950 to 1980.

**Baden**

The Baden series consists of newspaper clippings, church histories, and *Baden Through The Years: A History of Early Baden*, a 40-page booklet chronological account of Baden's founding and growth from its origins in the mid-19th century to 1956. The booklet documents the founding and evolution of Baden-area municipal services, schools, and churches, in addition to

identifying the first professionals (dentists, doctors, and lawyers) to migrate to the community. The materials in this collection are arranged by the date of their accession, dating from 1956 to 1973.

### **Bellefontaine Neighbors**

This series contains Bellefontaine Neighbors Board of Alderman meeting minutes, student reports, and newspaper clippings regarding Bellefontaine Neighbors municipal operations in the 1960s. For example, the series includes term papers on the community's Board of Alderman meetings, government officials, zoning ordinances, and "current problems and issues" facing the community, such as a lack of commercial enterprises. One student report, *Election 1966: The City of Bellefontaine Neighbors*, includes summaries of interviews the author conducted with candidates for the Board of Alderman and their campaign literature. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1964 to 1968.

### **Berkeley**

The bulk of the materials in this series consists of annual reports commissioned by Berkeley, Missouri's City Manager, housing studies written by the University of Missouri-St. Louis's Political Science Department, street maps, and newspaper clippings. Directed by professors Bryan T. Downes and E. Terrence Jones in 1972, the housing studies analyzed residential blight in Berkeley by surveying 250 homes in the area, conducted citizen surveys on neighborhood housing and school quality, and provided recommendations for reversing housing blight in the community. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1964 to 1973.

### **Bridgeton**

This series consists of histories, reports, zoning ordinances, newspaper clippings, and a proposed charter documenting the municipal operations of Bridgeton, Missouri. Other components of the series are photographs, fliers, bylaws, program booklets, and newspaper clippings regarding the Carrollton Players, a community theater group founded in 1959 by residents of the Carrollton subdivision in Bridgeton, Missouri. Materials of interest regarding the Carrollton Players include a program book for *Bus Stop* and cast photographs for the play *Lovers and Other Strangers*. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1960 to 1973.

### **Clayton**

This series contains student reports, histories, reports, maps, calendars, and newspaper clippings primarily regarding Clayton, Missouri's municipal government. For instance, this series includes a report on Clayton's central business district, written by Harland Bartholomew and Associates for Clayton's City Plan Commission. The report, written in 1957, analyzes past and current trends in population, tax rates, commerce and retail sales, building permits, the condition of the central business district in 1957 (store and office space, parking, and traffic), and offers several proposals to improve the district, such as street improvements, additional off-street parking facilities, and financing methods for parking facilities. Also included in the series is a commemorative program booklet for Clayton's bicentennial celebrations, held at Shaw Park, July 3-4, 1976. The booklet contains a schedule of events, advertisements for local-area businesses of the era, and a history of Clayton featuring photographs of early and municipal services. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1931 to 1976.

## **Crestwood**

This series contains reports on municipal governance, land use, and city planning for Crestwood, Missouri. Items of note include a report titled *Background For Planning: Community Profile of Crestwood, Missouri*, written by the Crestwood Plan Commission in 1962. The authors drafted the report to serve as a guidepost for a future comprehensive plan that would guide Crestwood's decisions about zoning and land use. As a result, the report provides data on housing, regional trade, population characteristics (family size, race, income, age, and marital status), and problem areas along Highway 66, the community's major thoroughfare. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1962 to 1964.

## **Creve Coeur**

This series consists of student reports, maps, pamphlets, ordinances, and histories about Creve Coeur's municipal government. The bulk of the materials in this series contains term papers written by the University of Missouri-St. Louis's political science students, such as *Small Town Politics: 1966*, by Ruth E. Knapp, which evaluates the Creve Coeur municipal elections of 1966. The report includes interviews with incumbents, including Creve Coeur's mayor John T. Bierne, who lists his accomplishments—including low taxes, well-maintained roads, and effective trash and garbage removal—and his denials of accusations of racism resulting from the community's refusal to accept African American residents and Jewish congregations. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1950 to 1973.

## **Ferguson**

Annual reports, newsletters, reports, calendars, and newspaper clippings regarding Ferguson, Missouri's municipal government and local community institutions and organizations comprise this series. Materials of interest include a booklet titled *Old Homes and Buildings of Ferguson*, published by the Ferguson Historical Society. The booklet contains brief descriptions of historic properties, such as Ferguson Station, Almeda Place, and Central School, accompanied by photographs of the buildings and an 1894 map of Ferguson identifying the locations of these structures. Also of interest in this series is the publication *History of Ferguson City and Schools*. This 361-page publication contains community members' reminiscences of growing up in Ferguson, reprints of memorial addresses, and a student thesis on the community's founding, in addition to maps, tables, and charts documenting Ferguson's growth and schools. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1955 to 2011.

## **Florissant**

This series contains annual reports, zoning ordinances, maps, pamphlets, newspaper clippings, and a city charter regarding Florissant, Missouri's municipal government, religious institutions, and historic properties. Among the items of interest featured in this series is a pamphlet titled *Historical Old...Florissant, Missouri...Excitingly New!* The Business and Professional Women of Florissant created the pamphlet as a companion piece for the "Green Line Tour" of the city, featuring short descriptions of historic properties, such as Casa Alvarez, Sacred Heart Church, and Place D'Armes, along with a map identifying the locations for each property. Another item of note is a survey of Casa Alvarez, a French Colonial-style home, one of the oldest residences in the St. Louis area. The survey provides readers with a biography of the home's original owner, Eugenio Alvarez, and a detailed description of its interior and exterior,

situating the design elements within their historical context. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1933 to 1944.

### **Village of Hanley Hills**

This series contains newspaper clippings and the municipal and zoning codes for the Village of Hanley Hills materials. One of the most significant items in the series is *The Revised Code of the Village of Hanley Hills, Missouri*, which provides a comprehensive list of municipal codes enacted by the Board of Trustees until 1964. The regulations govern streets and sewers, municipal finance, traffic and vehicle control, public health, zoning and building, public morals and welfare, and police protection and public safety. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1964 to 1968.

### **Hazelwood**

Reports, zoning ordinances, maps, histories, and newspaper clippings regarding the municipal governance of Hazelwood comprise the bulk of this series. Included in this series is the December 1965 issue of *Hope Scope*, a newsletter published by the Hazelwood Organization for Public Enlightenment. The newsletter contains articles on new residents, the December meeting of Hazelwood's Board of Trustees, and an essay about the meaning of peace in the context of American soldiers fighting communists in Vietnam, reflecting the Cold War anxieties of the era. Other materials of note include an advertisement for a 1971 bond issue to increase the local sales tax to construct new parks in Hazelwood. The advertisement features an illustration of a proposed pool in Hazelwood, near the historic Knobbe property, an example of what the bond and sales tax increase would fund. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1964 to 1971.

### **Jennings**

This series consists of reports, pamphlets, and newspaper clippings documenting Jennings, Missouri's municipal government and community institutions. An item of interest in this series is an undated questionnaire titled *Political Leadership and City Council*, issued by Washington University's Department of Political Science to an unidentified Jennings municipal official. The completed questionnaire provides information about the number of city departments, full-time employees, salaries, property tax rates (1960-1965), and municipal services provided by Jennings. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1947 to 1973.

### **Kirkwood**

This series contains reports, brochures, newsletters, and newspaper clippings regarding Kirkwood's municipal government and its history. Materials of note is a report titled *The Urban Renewal Plan for the Monroe Place Urban Renewal Area*, written by General Planning and Resource Consultants for the Land Clearance for Redevelopment Authority of Kirkwood, Missouri. In the report, the authors outline their proposal for slum clearance and rehabilitation of Monroe Place, a 48-acre neighborhood located southwest of the community's primary business district. Also of interest is *A Kirkwood Celebration*, a 128-page book commemorating the community's centennial, with essays written by longtime residents, such as photographer Francis Scheidegger, on their lives in the community. The materials in this collection are arranged chronologically, dating from 1925 to 1997.

**Ladue**

This series comprises reports, maps, zoning ordinances, and newspaper clippings regarding Ladue, Missouri's municipal government. Included in this series is a survey conducted by the Social Planning Council of St. Louis and St. Louis County titled *Recreation in Ladue-Creve Coeur and Adjacent Area*. The survey identifies the available recreational amenities in the Ladue-Creve Coeur area and provides several recommendations for improvement. Among the recommendations are constructing one-acre parks/playgrounds per 100 population and establishing little league team sports. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1938 to 1977.

**Manchester**

This series consists of ordinances, student reports, and newspaper clippings about Manchester, Missouri's municipal government. One item of interest is a term paper written by a University of Missouri-St. Louis student, chronicling the community's history, residential layout, and government functions. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1956 to 1968.

**Meacham Park**

The Meacham Park series consists of one folder containing the book *A Brief History of Meacham Park, Mo.*, which chronicles the African American community's founding, growth, schools, civic clubs and organizations, housing, and the impact of the Vietnam War on the community. Written by William J. Jones (1921-1996), the book chronicles Meacham Park's history until 1989. The book also contains photographs of the J. Milton Turner School and its students, the First Baptist Church of Meacham Park, and notable community members.

**Moline Acres**

This series consists of reports, newspaper clippings, a map, and a history documenting the Moline Acres municipal government. Materials of interest include a term paper written by a University of Missouri-St. Louis Political Science student titled *City of Moline Acres, Missouri*. The report provides a brief history of the community, identifies major government officials and their duties as they existed in the mid-1960s, and provides an account of one of the city council meetings the author attended on April 13, 1965. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1961 to 1969.

**Normandy**

Reports, histories, pamphlets, brochures, zoning ordinances, traffic codes, and newspapers regarding Normandy, Missouri's municipal government and community constitute this series. Some noteworthy items in this series include reports on Normandy's housing market. For example, *The Housing Market in Integrating Areas*, a report published by the Center of Community and Metropolitan Studies at the University of Missouri-St. Louis focuses on the impact integration had on Normandy's housing market. Other materials of interest include histories of St. Ann's Church and St. Vincent's Asylum. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1946 to 1984.



## **Olivette**

This series consists of reports, histories, ordinances, and newspaper clippings documenting the municipal governance of Olivette, Missouri, and the community's overall history. Included in this series is *Future Plan for the City of Olivette*, a map highlighting the municipal government's plans to redevelop the community to remove blight and broaden the city's tax base. Published in 1964 with funding from the federal government's Urban Planning Assistance Program, the map delineates plans for office and industrial districts, pedestrian walkways, and commercial areas. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1957 to 2005.

## **Overland**

This series contains meeting minutes, reports, pamphlets, newspaper clippings, maps, and a newsletter, regarding Overland, Missouri, including its municipal government. Items of note include brochures advertising Overland to prospective residents, such as *A Day in the Life of Mr. and Mrs. Overland*. Published by the City of Overland in 1960, this booklet provides a detailed listing of city services, accompanied by photographs depicting these municipal services. Another example is *City of Overland: The Well Balanced Community*, published in 1963. This brochure delineates the residential, recreational, religious, and educational amenities Overland offered its residents during this period, as well as job opportunities and shopping areas. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1956 to 1976.

## **Pagedale**

The bulk of this series constitutes ordinances, regulations, newspaper clippings, and reports chronicling the municipal governance of Pagedale, Missouri, primarily in the 1950s and 1960s. Some items of interest include a term paper written by a University of Missouri-St. Louis Political Science student about Pagedale's municipal government. The report covers the structure of Pagedale's local government, profiles city officials, describes the typical Pagedale board meeting, identifies public services provided by the city, and delineates sources of revenue for the city. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1952 to 1968.

## **Richmond Heights**

This series consists of reports, maps, newspaper clippings, and a zoning ordinance documenting Richmond Heights, Missouri's municipal government and history. An item of interest in this series includes *The History of Richmond Heights*, written by a senior English class at Maplewood-Richmond Heights High School. The documents the community's founding in 1912, followed by the structure and functions of Richmond Heights' municipal government as it existed in 1939. The authors also provide brief descriptions of the community's local housing market, commercial district, and hospital, in addition to profiles of local community organizations, such as the Boy Scouts, the American Legion, and the Richmond Heights Business Association. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1939 to 1966.

## **Riverview**

This series contains reports and newspaper clippings documenting Riverview's municipal government. An item of note in this series is a report written by a Political Science student at the University of Missouri-St. Louis titled *The Village of Riverview*. The report follows a similar structure as the reports written by the University's Political Science students featured in the

previous series: it contains a brief history of the community's founding, followed by descriptions of the Board of Trustees meetings and city services. A unique aspect of the report is the author's description and criticisms of the Board of Trustees, commenting on the factional disputes between board members and name-calling during one of their meetings. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1964 to 1973.

### **St. Ann**

This series contains reports, newspaper clippings, and a pamphlet chronicling St. Ann, Missouri's history and municipal government. Materials of interest include a pamphlet announcing St. Ann's newly constructed City Hall. The pamphlet features an artist's rendering of the structure, including a summary of its design and offices, including the Civil Defense Emergency Operating Center. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1964 to 1972.

### **St. John**

The series consists of reports, ordinances, newspaper clippings, a history, and a map chronicling St. John, Missouri's history and municipal government. Some items of interest include *The St. John Police Department: A Survey Report*, written by the Governmental Research Institute at the request of St. John's Board of Trustees. The authors survey the department's record-keeping practices, criminal investigating procedures, personnel and training, and criminal activity in the community, among other topics. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1948 to 1968.

### **University City**

This series contains reports, histories, and maps chronicling University City, Missouri's history and municipal government. Materials of interest include *Maryland Terrace: Its History and Architecture*, written by Esley Hamilton. The booklet covers the subdivision's founding, promotion, architecture, and residents. Included in the booklet are hand-drawn illustrations of the homes, accompanied by captions noting their various design elements. Some other items of interest in the University City series are reports on housing integration in the community during the 1960s and 1970s. For example, *The Role of Community Organizations in the Process of Racial Transition* chronicles the University City Residential Services' efforts to integrate the community's housing market, ensuring both Black and white residents had equal access to the area's housing stock. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1926 to 1998.

### **Webster Groves**

Reports, regulations, newsletters, flyers, and newspaper clippings documenting the history of Webster Groves and its municipal government comprise the bulk of this series. Materials of interest *In Retrospect: Webster Groves, Missouri*, a multi-volume history of the community conducted by the Webster Groves Local History Project at Webster Groves Senior High School. The volumes consist of oral histories students conducted with longtime residents on a variety of topics, including childhood, school, church, race relations, and businesses. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1930 to 1976.



## Woodson Terrace

The last series in this collection features reports, newspaper clippings, maps, and ordinances documenting Woodson Terrace, Missouri's municipal government. An item of interest in this series is *The City of Woodson Terrace, Missouri Report of the Citizens' Committee on Law Enforcement*. The report surveys the existing Police Department programs and makes recommendations for improved services. The materials in this series are arranged chronologically, dating from 1967 to 1970.
