Abstract: This collection contains a diary written by John Wilson, an English immigrant. In the diary, Wilson chronicles his daily life in the first decade of the twentieth century, discussing the social and political life of St. Louis and Jennings, Missouri, and the St. Louis World's Fair of 1904.

Biographical Note:

John Wilson was born in England in February 1831. Wilson immigrated to the United States and landed in New York on September 12, 1852. Mr. Wilson settled in St. Louis shortly thereafter. Mr. Wilson married Jane Wilson, an immigrant from Scotland, in 1860. Their daughter, Mary Wilson, was born in Missouri in July 1871. The Wilson family later moved to Jennings, Missouri, during the 1880s. He worked and became a stockholder at the M. A. Seed Dryplate manufacturing plant in Jennings, Missouri. John Wilson died on January 25, 1910, in Jennings, Missouri.

Arrangement:

The collection has been arranged chronologically.

Scope and Content Note:

The collection consists of 263 pages of daily diary entries written by John Wilson from January 6, 1904, to November 29, 1904, and from April 1, 1906, to December 25, 1909. In the diary, Wilson recounts his social and cultural experiences in St. Louis and Jennings, including the 1904 World's Fair, where he witnessed a John Phillips Sousa performance and Theodore Roosevelt's visit to the World's Fair. Also included in the diary is Wilson's description of the 1907 hot air balloon race in St. Louis, Missouri. The collection has been arranged chronologically and covers the years of 1904 and 1906-1909.
