Abstract: The Second National Woman's Gathering met in St. Louis at Fontbonne College on August 17-20, 1984. The Gathering was intended to empower women and reject the powerless and inferior gender roles placed upon them by society. The materials in this collection include a registration sheet, *Off The Wall II*, two cassette tapes documenting the Gathering, and a 16mm film entitled *Women's Voices: The Gender Gap Movie*.

Historical Note:

Sonia Johnson, Susan Horwitz, and Mary Beall called the first national Woman Gathering held in Washington, DC in August 1983. This gathering drew one hundred and sixty-five women. After that, hundreds of smaller gatherings have been held around the country.

On August 17-20, 1984, the second national Woman Gathering met at Fontbonne College in St. Louis, Missouri. At this conference, Sonia Johnson, 1984 Citizen's Party presidential candidate, spoke of the need for women to reject roles of powerlessness and inferiority and to take themselves seriously. Other events at the conference included street theater in which women reenacted the 1929 Igbo women riots against unfair taxes in Nigeria, as well as demonstrations in front of the St. Louis County Court house and the Reagan-Bush headquarters. The demonstrations celebrated women's rights and the rights of other marginalized people.

Arrangement:

The collection has been arranged into one folder and includes two cassette tapes and a 16mm film.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection contains a registration sheet, two cassette tape recordings of speakers at the Gathering, and *Women's Voices: The Gender Gap Movie*, which is recorded on a 16 mm film and was used by the National Organization of Women during the 1934 presidential election. The collection also includes *Off the Wall II*, a chronicle of the second national Woman Gathering. These materials relate to the Second National Woman's Gathering, held in St. Louis. The majority of the materials in this collection date from August 17, 1984 to August 20, 1984.
