The YouthBridge Community Foundation Records (formerly the German General Protestant Orphan's Home and General Protestant Children's Home) contain meeting minutes, ledgers, and scrapbooks relating to its history as a home for impoverished orphans. Materials of interest include intake record books, documenting the child's name, birth date, the reasons for their admittance and dismissal from the orphanage, as well as the names of their parents. Also included in the collection are photographs depicting the cornerstone laying of YouthBridge's former campus at 12685 Olive Street Road and an essay on the history of YouthBridge, titled *Still Caring: the Evolution of a St. Louis Orphanage*, by Glenn J. Sartori. The materials in this collection date from 1877 to 2003.
