Approximately 12 cubic feet

James W. Symington was the Democratic U.S. Representative from Missouri's second congressional district from 1968-1976. His papers include correspondence, legislative material, speeches, press releases, congressional statements, opinion files, district project files, military case files, campaign material, newsletters, clippings, photographs, video tapes and films.

James Symington was born in 1927 to Stuart and Evelyn Symington in Rochester, New York. The family moved to St. Louis in 1937, where James attended Country Day School. In 1945 he graduated from Deerfield Academy in Massachusetts and joined the Marine Corps. After his military service, Symington got a B.A. from Yale and an LL.B. from Columbia in 1954. For the next two years, he served as Assistant City Counselor for St. Louis. He entered private practice with Cobbs, Armstrong, Teasdale, and Roos from 1955-1957. Symington then became an Associate with D'Arcy Advertising Company. In 1958 he was Assistant to John Hay Whitney, Ambassador to Great Britain until 1960, when he returned to private practice with Arnold Fortas and Porter in Washington D.C. Symington became Administrative Assistant to Attorney General Robert Kennedy in 1962. In 1964 he once again returned to private practice. In 1965 he became Executive Director of the President's Committee on Juvenile Delinquency until his appointment as United States Chief of Protocol in 1966. Symington was elected as Representative of Missouri's Second district in 1968 and served in the U.S. House until 1977.
