Dougherty began his political career in 1978 when he won a seat in the Missouri House of Representatives against 12-year incumbent, John J. Blassie. He served in the House until 2001, when he was elected to the Missouri Senate in a special election for the 4th District. Due to term limits, Dougherty retired from the Missouri Senate in 2006.
