Louis Gabard was a member of the French Mutual Aid Society in St. Louis. Adele Marie Oheim was a postal worker and a member of the National Association of Letter Carriers. She was also a member of the St. Louis area Letter Carriers Kitchen Band.

Arrangement:

The collection has been arranged chronologically into 4 folders.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection contains photographs, French ribbons, and a Cleveland High School newsletter. The materials largely concern Louis Gabard and Adele Marie Oheim. Some of the photographs depict the National Association of Letter Carriers, of which Adele Marie Oheim was a member. Also included in this collection are sample ballots from 1944 Missouri elections, Muny programs, a 1904 World's Fair map, and a Meramec School Picnic program.
