Biographical Note:

Robert Dale Miller, son of Mr. and Mrs. R. L. Miller of Middletown, Ohio, served in the U.S. Coast Guard during World War II. Following Miller's discharge, he married Geneva Rhoads, daughter of Sarah and Faris Rhoads of Middletown, OH, in 1946. However, they were divorced soon after.

Arrangement:

The collection has been arranged chronologically into one folder.

Scope and Content:

The Robert D. Miller Correspondence contains 13 letters written by Miller at the Warwick Hotel in St. Louis, Missouri to Geneva Rhoads in Middletown, Ohio in October 1945. Miller, a member of the U.S. Coast Guard, wrote about his love for Geneva and wanting to get discharged from service so he could go home to her. Robert also wrote of how he entertained himself in St. Louis, listening to music, seeing movies, and drinking with friends. The materials in this collection date from October 14, 1945, to October 30, 1945, and are arranged chronologically.
