

**S1123 DREY, KAY, FORT LEONARD WOOD COLLECTION, 1971-2004
256 FOLDERS, 19 REPORTS, 21 BOOKS**

In 1995 the Coalition for the Environment made a legal challenge to state agency permits and variances granted to Fort Leonard Wood, the US Army base located 130 miles from St. Louis. The permits and variances allowed the base to move into the Missouri Ozarks its nerve gas, germ warfare, chemical weapons center and “obscurant” training program, involving highly polluting metallic dust clouds. The courts set aside agency actions after the two proceedings initiated by the Coalition.

At a 1999 public hearing before the Department of Natural Resources on the Fort Leonard Wood draft air and water permits the Coalition brought forth concern about the effects of fog oil and chemical weapons on the ecosystem, wildlife and people of the Big Riney River and Robidoux creek. The permits were required for operation of the Fort Leonard Wood Army Chemical Weapons Training Facility.

This addendum includes files pertaining to the legal actions against Fort Leonard Wood. It also contains reviews of the scientific literature, environmental assessments and toxicological profiles of chemical agents. The collection also includes books on arms control, landmines, germ, chemical and nuclear warfare and the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction.
