Historical Note:

The Church of the Holy Cross, Evangelical Lutheran was organized in 1858 out of Concordia Seminary in Saint Louis, Missouri. The church's present building was completed in 1889 and is located on Ohio and Miami Avenues (2650 Miami Street). A large part of the congregation was of German descent.

In the 1890s the church's pastor was Rev. C. C. Schmidt, and the church's ministry work included the Lutheran Hospital and Orphans Home; the church also had a school hall and ran the Holy Cross School. One pupil who attended the school in the 1890s was child actor Alice Flood. The original school hall was destroyed by a fire in the fall of 1913 and a new school building was constructed in 1914.

Holy Cross Lutheran Church is still active today and is the site of the present-day Kairos Academy.
