Biographical Note:

Frank Cowan was born June 11, 1913, the child of Lemuel Lewis Cowan and Fannie Abbott Cowan. In 1934 Frank married Norma Rae Ellis. In 1949 they moved to Golden City where they had two daughters Norma Lou and Donna Kay. Donna attended Golden City High School where she was active in drama and Future Homemakers of America. She graduated in 1958. After earning a business degree at the University of Missouri in 1962 Donna married Robert Donald Atkinson and they had two sons, James Robert Atkinson and Philip Craig Atkinson. Donna worked at Septagon Construction, a Butler Franchise General Contractor, from 1979 to 2005. She also worked nine years for the Missouri State Archives as a genealogical researcher.

Scope and Content Note:

The collection consists of pamphlets, booklets, photographs, and correspondence of the Cowan Family. Of particular note are materials pertaining to Golden City High School class of 1933 and 1958.
