Biographical Note:

Claib E. (Claiborne Ethelburt) Duval was born in Rutledge, Missouri, on December 25, 1858 to Dr. William C. Duval and Mary J. Boyer. He married Mary J. Hamilton on February 23, 1882. They had four children: Clarice, Claude, Bessie, and Vincil. Claib worked as a publisher and businessman in Pineville, Missouri. He published the *Saratoga Eagle*, the *Pineville News*, and the *Pineville Herald*. Claib died on March 20, 1942, and is buried with his wife in the Pineville Cemetery.

Arrangement:

The photographs have been arranged by photograph type in nineteen folders, the photographs are undated. The photographs in the collection are grouped by the subject matter. Unlabeled photographs were separated from the others. The documents were grouped by subject and arranged chronologically.

Scope and Content:

The Duval Family Photographs consist of 266 photographs, tintypes, and cabinet cards that document the lives of Claib E. Duval and his family and friends. The majority of the images in the collection are labeled with the names of their subjects, although few are labeled with the date or location. The studios at which the cabinet cards and other posed portraits were produced were predominately located in Southwest Missouri. The documents in the collection include several advertisements for garages in Pineville, Missouri, and local political candidates, obituaries, holiday cards, calling cards, several employee cards from the Missouri Pacific Railway, and a few documents relating to the newspaper business.
