Virginia Beaver was born April 4, 1912, the daughter of Charles Wilson Beaver and Frances Loretta Hudson. She attended the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville, Arkansas, where she trained to be a teacher. She graduated in 1933 and on February 3, 1935, she married Lynn C. Smith. They had two daughters, Ginni and Francis. Virginia taught music at Springdale High School for many years. She had a keen interest in genealogy, was a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution, and maintained correspondence with other researchers who had a similar interest. She passed away in 1986 at the age of 73.
