Biographical Note:

Arthur Richard Hill Jr. was born February 5, 1904, to Arthur Richard Hill and Bennie Mae (Black) Hill in Hope, Arkansas. As an adult, Arthur attended National Art School in Washington D.C. During the 1960s and 1970s, Arthur came to Missouri and took photographs of various

Missouri towns. Arthur's sister, Nona Frances (Hill) Vise, married Thomas Sidney Vise in 1931. The couple lived in Arkansas and had one child, Sidney Richard Vise, who was born December 22, 1931.

Arthur's permanent residence and date of death are unknown.
